- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - Original Survey by Francis Coleman B.T.'s Beech, 12" N48°E 11 lks.; Sugar, 12" S32°W 33 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.
 - L.C.R.C. No. 843 by William Lenca, RLS No. 26461, states "set 1/2" x 24" Iron/Ident. cap in line with ancient fence West, c/l of old lane East and c/l of Co. Rd. N-S. TIES: Power Pole - N49°E - 53.66'; Cedar, 4" - S40°E - 35.71'; Power Pole -1989: S34°W - 49.85', Cedar, 8" - S88°W - 32.96'.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We recovered a 1/2 inch x 24 inch iron in position as described in L.C.R.C. No. 843 (see part A). This location fits well with measurments to corners 1/2 mile North (GLO = 2605.7' - MEAS. = 2589.72') and 1/2 mile South (GLO = 2605.7' - MEAS. = 2590.13'), and with long standing lines of occupation, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.
