B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

In a 1994 Survey of Section 19, T38N-R25W, we found the rotted remains of a squared wood post in line with fences North and West from this location. The post fits closely with a proportioned position for this corner, and appears to have been relied upon by local land owners. We accepted the squared wood post as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
