All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements. L.C.R.C. No. 672 by Neil Hill, RLS No. 27447, states "found bent iron pipe in c/l Co. Rd. @ fence East. Location fits occupation and comparison of GLO distances to existing corner monumentation is reasonable. Replaced bent iron with drift pin." B.T.'s: 4" Balsam - S55°E - 22.98'; 9" W. Pine - N20°W - 58.00"; 8" Ash - S80°E - 24.51'; 8" W. Pine - S45°W - 25.60'. B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: We recovered a 3/4 inch diameter x 18 inch iron pipe in the centerline of a North - South County Road, and in line with an ancient fence line running East. We also found the 2 White Pine B.T.'s described in L.C.R.C. No. 672 matching the position of the found iron pipe.
