

1, William Lonca , in a field survey on Sopt 03, 19 97 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original Survey by Harvey Mellen - B.T.'s - W. Pine, 36" - S60°W - 07 lks.; Sugar, 12" - N35°E - 26 lks. Remnants of large White Pine stump found at proper location for original B.T.

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: Found old squared post with tags and blazes on trees. Also found paint lines South and East with cutting to this line from the West. Recovered rotted remains of a large White Pine stump in proper location for original B.T. The location of the old squared post checks well with the position of the White Pine stump. We accepted the position of the old squared wood post as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.
