All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by County Road improvements. 1964: L.C.R.C. No. 500 (Vol. 3) by Neal Sperhake, Surveyor for Kimberly Clark Corp., established a Witness Corner 20 feet South of the corner location. He describes the W.C. as a 1" Iron Pipe 3' long with Alum. cap denoted "KIMBERLY-CLARK CORP. - TIES: Cedar, 8" - N11°W - 84.5 lks; Cedar, 6" - S30°W - 59 lks; Cedar, 10" - S68°E - 32 lks. He states that the corner was established in the centerline of an East - West County Road and in line with an old fence running south. B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: We found a Railroad Spike in the centerline of an East - West County Road and in line with an old fence line running South. The Railroad Spike is 20 feet North of the Witness Corner described in L.C.R.C. No. 500. This corner has been used by local surveyors for at least 30 years, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
