H-3 [N1/4 COR S.10] NO CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND AS ALL EVIDENCE OF CORNER POSITION APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN DESTROYED DURING ROAD CONSTRUCTION. RESTORED CORNER POSTION FROM TESTIMONY OF MR. JOHN KUTHA, PROPERTY OWNER AND LIFELONG RESIDENT OF THE AREA WHO KNEW OF THE EXISTANCE OF AN IRON PIN MONUMENT PRIOR TO THE RECONSTRUCTION OF THE E & W COUNTY ROAD. THIS POSITION FALLS AT THE APPROX C/L INTERSECTION OF COUNTY ROADS E, W, & S. ACCEPTED THIS LOCATION AS BEING THE BEST AVAILABLE EVIDENCE AS TO THE POSITION OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER.
