No original evidence for this corner was recovered. L.C.R.C. No. 334 by Robert E. Schmeling, RLS No. 8317, states that a he set a 1" dia. x 4' iron pipe/brass cap in place of an 1981: existing 1-1/2" iron pipe/brass cap badly decayed. He states that the existing monument was placed by Oliver Mining Company employee George Grogan from original B.T.'s - TIES: 6" Aspen - N08°E - 7.6'; 8" Aspen - S15°E - 3.1'; 8" Aspen - N850W - 5.5'; 6" Aspen - N210W - 15.3'. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: We found a 1" diameter iron pipe/3" diameter brass cap stamped for corner in location indicated by GLO Terrain Calls. The 4 bearing trees described in L.C.R.C. No. 334 still exist and check with corner location. The corner position also fits well with GLO Terrain calls to swamp edges 5 chains North and 2.16 chains East. This corner has been accepted and used as the corner position for many years. Since there is record evidence that this corner was replaced from original bearing trees, we accepted the corner location as a careful and faithful pernetuation of the position of the original corner.
