

Sikkema , in a field survey on <u>August 15</u> _, 19 99 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
- I-10, One-quarter Corner common to Sections 27 & 26, T21N, R7W, a post was set in 1856 by Deputy Surveyor, Colman, witnessed by: N41°E - 10" Fir - 5 Links S52°W - 8" W. Pine - 30 Links

The County Surveyor visited this corner in 1894 for a survey in Section 27 and witnessed by: 24" W. Pine Stump - West - 2 Links Then the corner was visited again in 1910 for a survey in Section 27 and a 4x4 cedar post was set with no witnesses given.

Mark Robison Certificate of Survey in 1995 shows estab. the E-W 1/4 line with no reference being made to the W 1/4 Corner. Per phone call to Mark he set an iron and cap by S.P., witnessed by: N44°E-8.03'-F.P.; N60°E-11.35'-8"x8"F.P.; N10°W-24.20'-42" Maple; \$25°E-21.35'-F.P.

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- 1-10, Found 1/2" Iron with cap #15410 (Delmer Porter) at intersection of old fences North, South and East. Corner appears to have been reset by occupation. Porter Iron also fits 1/8th line fence to the West 1/4 mile South. Also found 1/2" Iron with cap #9433 set by Robison which appears to have been set by Single Proportion and is approximately 6' south and 4' West of Porter's corner. Accepted Porter's position which best fits occupation. This Corner is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
