- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:
- J11 1/4 Corner common to Sec. 26 & 35 Couldn't find any evidence of GLO post, BT's or perpetuation by Beuthien. Retraced N-S 1/4 line per Beuthien petition survey of Sec. 35 and find Beuthien's CS 1/16 (#12), C1/4 ('J12') and CN 1/16 (#5). These positions all line up with S ¼ Corner ('J13') of Sec. 35. Projected line from C ¼ ('J12') through CN 1/16 (#5) Sec. 35, at double distance North. Dug in swampy area (1' +/- organics-roots & grass over sand) 7' N, 3'± E, 12' ±W and 16' S of calculated position searching for evidence of wood stake but nothing found. Felt best way to reestablish corner was Beuthien monumentation to the South and project it North as calculated for search area. Thus from C ¼ Sec. 35 ('J12') N0°17'04"W 1316.39' (1312.08' – EAB) to CN 1/16 (#5) double North at N0°17'04"W 1316.39' (1312.08'-EAB) and set 4" DNR Alum. Cap on 1" x 4' long galv. iron pipe. Measured grid bearing and distance of S88'51'12"E 2644.24' (2623.5'-GLO, 2659.8'-EAB, 2618.95'- KJO) to 'K11' and N88°57'20"W 2589.99' (2623.5'-GLO, 2577.3'-EAB, 2618.95'-KJO) to calculated position of 'I-11'. DNR Mon. accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
 - Reference Pt. S84°25'E 27.85' of 'J11' Found 4" DOC Alum. Cap Monument per K. J. Ostling. Reviewed Ostling's field notes but could not find any evidence that he retraced any of Beuthien's interior monumentation of section 35 to see if his position comformed to the 1913 petition survey. Since Ostling's position doesn't conform with Beuthien's Petition Survey of Sec. 35, could not accept it as 'J11' in this survey. Replace DOC Mon. on 1" pipe with ½" x 18" iron rebar.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

J11 - 4" DNR Alum. Cap on 1" x 48" galv. iron pipe

Set Blue Carsonite Post 1' N.
