

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:
- J13 J1 Standard ¼ Corner common to Sec. 35, T22N, R5W & Sec. 2, T21N, R5W Fd. 4" Dept. of Conservation (DOC) Brass Cap on 1" pipe per Ostling and Roser. No GLO or CSR Wits. found. DOC Mon. on N. Edge of 8'± wide stream Coarse West through sawgrass marsh. The monument was leaning S'ly, straighten to fit record wits. DOC (DNR) Mon. accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

J13 – J1 – 4" DOC (DNR) Brass Cap on 1" galv. iron pipe
Set Blue Carsonite Post 1' SW
ENE 0.5' to face fd. 6" Cedar post
S 0.5' to face fd. 4" Cedar post – scribed
N17°E 34.1' to face blaze dead 16" Ash (KJO, CFR, GJG)
N87°E 69.75' to set N & T in S. side 7" Ash (CFR, GJG)
N19°W 44.57' to set ½" x 18" rebar

N42°E 55.02' to set 5/8" x 18" rebar West 44.57' to set ½" x 1.1' iron pipe CRAIG W.
