- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
  - L-13) 1839 GLO Quarter Section post by John Brink, Deputy Surveyor; Hemlock 8-N38E-43, Hemlock 8-N36W-22
  - L-13) 1914 Beuthien Survey in Section 1, T22N, R6W; Cedar Stake (old corner), WPS 26-N70E-84, Cherry 6-N321/2W-163
  - L-13) 1918 Beuthien Survey in Section 36, T23N, R6W.
  - L-13) 1958 MDOT Survey M-55, F 388(2) Part 2: No corner shown.
  - L-13) 1972 Cavanagh Survey; working drawing shows no corner set.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
  - L-13) Quarter Section Corner Common to Section 36, T23N, R6W and Section 1, T22N, R6W. Reestablished corner by single proportion between the section corners found one half mile to the East and West. The position also fits a 1914 Beuthien wit., Cherry 6-N32 1/2°W-163 which is still standing. This position is ±41' West of the centerline of road to the North and a fence line to the South and in the centerline of East-West Road. The difference between the Quarter Section corner and the road to the North is noted on the 1918 Beuthien Survey notes. This corner is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
