C7 – Section corner common to sections 17, 18, 19 & 20, T23N, R7W - Found Beuthien witness #4. This White Pine stp. being the only large Pine Stp. in area. Dug at record bearing and distance from Beuthein witness #4, but nothing conclusive for stake. GLO Witnesses are gone. Set 4" DNR Aluminum cap on 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe at record bearing and distance from E. A. Beuthein 40" WPS remains (#4). Fits West 1/16 line occupation ½ mile east.
