

- E7 Section corner common to sections 16, 17, 20 & 21, T24N, R7W Found 1" x 31" I. D. iron pipe with conc. pieces at base down 0.4' in centerline N-S 2-track. Found witnesses from J. G. Cavanagh, M. A. Koivisto, J. L. Wilcox, and C. F. Roser. 1" pipe is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
