Found 1" solid iron rod 18" long and large blue stone on its side next to it with smaller stones all around and very old wood stake, on tree line East and West and fence line and centerline of road North is 4 ft East and measured 2654.63 ft from the N.W. Cor. to the W. ¼ Cor. and measured 2637.71 ft from the W. ¼ Cor. to the S.W. Cor. of Sec. 20 and the condition of the recorded witness are: #1 thru #4 gone, #5 thru #9 good condition.

C. DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT FOR CORNER AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE LOCATING T POSITION OF THE CORNER:
