B. DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND AND/OR METHOD APPLIED IN RESTORING OR REESTABLISHING CORNER:

Found ¾" Rod raised with ½" x 18" Rerod in monument box. On line ± with the centerline of bituminous road going North and the centerline of the East and West bituminous road is 2 feet ± North. There is no apparent occupation going South. The condition of the recorded witnesses are: #1 thru #14 gone, #15 and #16 good condition, #17 gone, #18 good condition.

C. DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT FOR CORNER AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE LOCATING THE POSITION OF THE CORNER:

Removed ½" x 18" Rerod and set a 4" diameter Harrison cast iron monument 20" long marked "County Surveyor" over ¾" Rod in a monument box as a substantial marker for the quarter corner and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
