Found 5" x 5" Concrete monument with 3" diameter brass disk (20" ± below grade). The centerline of the East and West bituminous road is 12.5 feet ± North and the power line going South is 16 feet ± East. There is no occupation going North. The condition of the recorded witnesses are: #1 and #2 gone, #3 good condition, #4 gone, #5 and #6 good condition, #7 and #8 gone, #9 new pole, #10 gone, #11 thru #17 good condition.

#### C. DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT FOR CORNER AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE LOCATING THE POSITION OF THE CORNER:

Accepted 5" x 5" concrete monument with 3" diameter brass disk, set a ½" x 18" Rerod on West side to help locate with schonestatdt, 1" below top of monument as a substantial marker for the quarter corner and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
