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# B. DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND AND/OR METHOD APPLIED IN RESTORING OR REESTABLISHING CORNER:

Found 4" diameter Harrison cast iron monument, 2 inches below bituminous, on line ± with centerline of bituminous road going North. The centerline of the East and West bituminous road is 1 foot North. The tree row going South is 3 feet East. The condition of the recorded witnesses are: #1 thru #4 gone, #5 good condition, #6 gone, #7 stump, #8 good condition, #9 and #10 gone, #11 thru #13 good condition.

# C. DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT FOR CORNER AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE LOCATING THE POSITION OF THE CORNER:

Accepted 4" diameter Harrison cast iron monument 36" long marked "County Surveyor" as a substantial marker for the quarter corner and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the original corner.
