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B. DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND AND/OR METHOD APPLIED IN RESTORING OR REESTABLISHING CORNER:

Found 4" diameter Harrison cast iron monument 16" long marked "County Surveyor" in monument box. On line ± with the centerline of the East and West bituminous road, on line ± with the East edge of woods going North and on line ± with the East edge of pine plantation going South. The condition of the recorded witnesses are: #1 thru #8 gone, #9 good condition, #10 gone, #11 and #12 good condition, #13 found (broken 3" diameter concrete monument with ½" Rerod North 50' ±), #14 and #15 good condition.

C. DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT FOR CORNER AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE LOCATING THE POSITION OF THE CORNER:
