Found 4" diameter Harrison cast iron monument marked "County Surveyor" 6 inches ± below grade, on line ± with the centerline of bituminous road to the North extended South, on line ± with the centerline of gravel road to the South extended North and on line ± with the centerline of bituminous road to the West extended East. The centerline of gravel road going Northwest -Southeast is 42 feet ± West and there is no apparent occupation to the East. The condition of the recorded witnesses are: #1 thru #4 gone, #5 good condition, #6 thru #8 gone, #9 good condition, #10 gone, #11 good condition, #12 gone, #13 thru #15 did not measure, #16 good condition.
