### B. DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND AND/OR METHOD APPLIED IN RESTORING OR REESTABLISHING CORNER:

Found 4" diameter Harrison cast iron monument marked "County Surveyor" in the centerline of paved road going South extended and the centerline of the gravel drive is 15 feet ± East. The condition of the recorded witnesses are: #1 thru #5 gone, #6 did not measure, #7 thru #9 gone, #10 thru #13 good condition.

#### C. DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT FOR CORNER AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE LOCATING THE POSITION OF THE CORNER:

Accepted 4" diameter Harrison cast iron monument 20" long marked "County Surveyor" as a substantial marker for the section corner and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the original corner.
