## B. DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND AND/OR METHOD APPLIED IN RESTORING OR REESTABLISHING CORNER:

Found 24" Railroad Rall 10" ± below grade, raised with a ½" x 24" Rerod, raised with a ¾" x 6" Iron Pipe, on line ± with the centerline of the East and West bituminous road and on line ± with the centerline of the bituminous road going North. There is no apparent occupation going South. The condition of the recorded witnesses are: #1 thru #5 gone, #6 thru #8 good condition.

## C. DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT FOR CORNER AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE LOCATING THE POSITION OF THE CORNER:

Removed Railroad Rail, Rerod and Iron Pipe and set a 4" diameter Harrison cast iron monument 30" long marked "County Surveyor" as a substantial marker for the quarter corner and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner. NIC MIC
