Found Robert A. Griffin's concrete monument with top broke off bottom of mon okay. Also fd. bottom of old 4" X 4" forest service post with tag an broken glass under conc. mon and corner is 2 ft West of centerline of trail road South and corner is in centerline of dirt road west and the condition of the recorded witnesses are: #1 thru #3 gone, #4 thru #6 good condition.

C. DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT FOR CORNER AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE LOCATING TH POSITION OF THE CORNER:
