B. DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND AND/OR METHOD APPLIED IN RESTORING OR REESTABLISHING CORNER:

Found ½" X 20" iron Pipe over pointed wood post, broken off at grade, 26" long, 4"± diameter at top with two stones (G.L.O Post) also large stone 3'± below grade (possible G.L.O. Post). The condition of the recorded witnesses are: #1 stump, #2 stump hole, #3 stump, #4 thru #11 good condition.

C. DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT FOR CORNER AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE LOCATING THE POSITION OF THE CORNER:

Removed ½" X 20" Iron Pipe, Pointed Wood Post and two stones and set 4" diameter Harrison cast iron monument 36" long over large stone, marked "County Surveyor" as a substantial marker for the section corner and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the original corner.
