DOSSIER FOR: THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3, LYON TOWNSHIP, T 1 N, R 7 E, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN. Prepared under contract with the County of Oakland Under Act 345 of the Public Acts of 1990.

HISTORY:

This Township was originally surveyed by Joseph Wampler, Deputy Surveyor, in 1823.

SPECIAL NOTES:

This 1/4 Corner which was not set by the GLO has been used since before 1980 as evidenced by recordings under Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970 in Liber 7879, Page 205 of the Oakland County Records.

COLLATERAL EVIDENCE:

We found a wood hub referenced by Edward Anderson in 1980 at the North-South 1/4 Line of Section 3 and projected a line Due North to intersect the Township Line as defined by the South Line of Section 34 of Milford Township. The resulting 1/4 Corner lies 4 feet North of the North bank of a creek and on line with a tree row to the South.

We searched at least 50 feet in each direction for other stakes and found none that might represent the Corner. However, we did find another iron S. 4° E. 16.13 feet from the Section Corner, but could find no documentation or evidence to support it.

We could find no evidence to dispute the location of this Corner.

This Corner was set by us, but the Reference Corner was first recorded in 1980 by Edward C. Anderson in Liber 7879, Page 205, of the Oakland County Records.

SURVEYOR'S RECOMMENDATIONS:

Therefore, I recommend that the Peer Review Group accept this Corner as monumented, with the references as shown on the enclosed form prepared according to Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970.
