DOSSIER FOR: THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 2, LYON TOWNSHIP, T 1 N, R 7 E, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN. Prepared under contract with the County of Oakland Under Act 345 of the Public Acts of 1990.

HISTORY:

This Township was originally surveyed by Joseph Wampler, Deputy Surveyor, in 1823.

SPECIAL NOTES:

This 1/4 Corner which was not set by the GLO has been used since before 1990 as evidenced by recordings under Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970 in Liber 11308, Page 399 of the Oakland County Records.

COLLATERAL EVIDENCE:

We found an iron rod in a Monument Box referenced by Donald H. DeKeyser in 1990 at the North-South 1/4 Line of Section 2 and projected a line Due North to intersect the Township Line as defined by the South Line of Section 35 of Milford Township. The resulting 1/4 Corner lies in the Centerline of Pontiac Trail 0.05 North of the iron we found in the Monument Box and on line with a tree row to the South.

We searched at least 50 feet in each direction for other stakes and found none that might represent the Corner.

We could find no evidence to dispute the location of this Corner and the measured distance to the Northeast Corner of Section 2 agrees with the distance from an unrecorded survey by Thomas W. Postiff in 1979 within one half of a foot.

This Section Corner was set by us, but the Reference Corner was first recorded in 1980 by Donald H. DeKeyser in Liber 11308, Page 399, of the Oakland County Records.

SURVEYOR'S RECOMMENDATIONS:
