5. Private Claims

I, John N. Redash, in a field survey on March 6, 1997 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Table with 4 columns: Date, Description, Name, and License/Notes. Includes entries for 1817, 1973, 1974, and 1986.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

A 1/2" iron in monument box currently occupies this corner. Current measurements match at minimum two ties each of all of the above listed L.C.R.C.'s. Field measurements were made between the following corners:

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I placed a 2" diameter brass cap stamped "Oakland County Remonumentation PS#37281" on the existing 1/2" iron monument box. Witnesses are as follows:
