DOSSIER FOR: THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 4, MILFORD TOWNSHIP, T 2 N, R 7 E, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN. Prepared under contract with the County of Oakland Under Act 345 of the Public Acts of 1990.

HISTORY:

This Corner was not set by the GLO when the Township Line was run or the Township was subdivided because it was in a pond, as it is today. This Corner was established by Boss Engineering in 1993 as evidenced by an unrecorded survey prepared at that time.

COLLATERAL EVIDENCE:

We set a concrete monument in place of an iron rod and cap by Boss Engineering on the Township Line 353.52 feet West of the Corner and 92 feet East of the Centerline of Central Boulevard. There is a Boss iron and cap N. 20° W. 8.97 from the reference point. We also found the reference point set by Boss Engineering on the East line of Section 5. We calculated the location for this Corner to be at the intersection of the line from the Southeast Corner of Section 5 through the Boss reference corner 907.14 feet (907.41 feet recorded) to the South and the South 1/4 Corner of Section 32 of Highland Township through the Boss reference corner 353.52 feet (353.59 feet recorded) to the West. We searched at least 50 feet in each direction for other stakes and found none that might represent the Corner.

SURVEYOR'S RECOMMENDATIONS:

This corner location is accepted by the Contractor and is generally accepted by Professional Surveyors as the best available evidence of the position of the original Corner. Therefore, I recommend that the Peer Review Group accept this Corner as monumented, with the references as shown on the enclosed form prepared according to Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970.
