



DOSSIER FOR: THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 9, MILFORD TOWNSHIP, T 2 N, R 7 E, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN. Prepared under contract with the County of Oakland Under Act 345 of the Public Acts of 1990.

HISTORY:

This Corner has been accepted and used since before 1959 as witnessed by the Road Commission for Oakland County at that time. It was recorded under Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970 in Liber 6965, Page 92, by Huston K. Kennedy, Surveyor in 1977.

COLLATERAL EVIDENCE:

We set a 5/8" iron rod and remonumentation cap in place of a 1/2" iron rod in an existing monument box 1 foot South and 5 feet West of the centerline intersection of General Motors Road with Granger Road. We measured 0.21 feet, 6.89 feet, 0.03 feet and 0.66 feet less than the record distances to the adjacent Government Corners to the North, East, South and West, respectively. We searched at least 50 feet in each direction for other stakes and found none that might represent the Corner.

SURVEYOR'S RECOMMENDATIONS:

This corner location is accepted by the Contractor and is generally accepted by Professional Surveyors as the best available evidence of the position of the original Corner. Therefore, I recommend that the Peer Review Group accept this Corner as monumented, with the references as shown on the enclosed form prepared according to Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970.
