

DOSSIER FOR: THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4, MILFORD TOWNSHIP, T 2 N, R 7 E, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN. Prepared under contract with the County of Oakland Under Act 345 of the Public Acts of 1990.

HISTORY:

This Corner was not originally set by the Government Surveyor. The North-South 1/4 Line has be monumented and witnessed since before 1973, as evidenced by an unrecorded survey by Finney and Kostecke and first recorded under Act 74 in 1989 by Kenenth G. Stevenson, Surveyor in L. 10841, P. 331.

COLLATERAL EVIDENCE:

We set a 5/8" iron rod and remonumentation cap on the Township Line 4.84 feet North of the 1/2" iron rod we found on the 1/4 Line. We calculated the distance to the Northwest Corner of Section 4 to be 0.23 feet less than the recorded distance and measured 0.15 feet less than the recorded distance to the Northeast Corner of the Section. There is a row of evergreen trees running South 32 feet East of the Corner. This Corner lies 3 feet South of the Centerline of Rowe Road. The South 1/4 Corner of Section 33 of Highland Township is 258.72 feet East of this Corner. We searched at least 50 feet in each direction for other stakes, and found none that might represent the Corner.

SURVEYOR'S RECOMMENDATIONS:

This corner location, although not established by an original government survey, is accepted by the Contractor and is generally accepted by Professional Surveyors as the best available evidence of the position of the corner. Therefore, I recommend that the Peer Review Group accept this Corner as monumented, with the references as shown on the enclosed form prepared according to Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970.
