DOSSIER FOR: THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26, MILFORD TOWNSHIP, T 2 N, R 7 E, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN. Prepared under contract with the County of Oakland Under Act 345 of the Public Acts of 1990.

HISTORY:

This Township was originally surveyed by Joseph Wampler, Deputy Surveyor, in 1823.

SPECIAL NOTES:

After reviewing the transcripts of the Original GLO Notes, I believe that the original survey lines were run as documented and that the dimensions seem to be accurate in the Southeast 1/4 of this Township, with our measurements agreeing within 10 to 15 feet, in practically all instances.

This Corner has been accepted and used since before 1956, as evidenced by the Oakland County Road Commission Records.

COLLATERAL EVIDENCE:

We found a railroad spike at the Centerline of the intersection of Saddle Lane and Maple Road. There is also a tree row to the South.

We searched at least 50 feet in each direction for other stakes and found none that might represent the Corner.

The measured dimensions to the Southwest and the Southeast Corners of Section 26 agree with the dimensions taken from recorded surveys, the most recent tax maps and/or other old surveys within 2.5 and 0.5 feet respectively.

This Corner was first recorded in 1972 by Raymond J. Kostecke in Liber 5991, Page 241, of the Oakland County Records.

SURVEYOR'S RECOMMENDATIONS:

Therefore, I recommend that the Peer Review Group accept this Corner as monumented, with the references as shown on the enclosed form prepared according to Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970.
