HISTORY:

This Township was originally surveyed by Joseph Wampler, Deputy Surveyor, in 1823.

SPECIAL NOTES:

After reviewing the transcripts of the Original GLO Notes, I believe that the original survey lines were run as documented and that the dimensions seem to be accurate in the Southeast 1/4 of this Township, with our measurements agreeing within 10 to 15 feet, in practically all instances.

This Corner has been accepted and used since before 1934, as evidenced by the Oakland County Road Commission Records.

COLLATERAL EVIDENCE:

We found an iron rod at the intersection of the Centerlines of Childs Lake and Buno Roads and on line with a fence line running North. There is also a fence line running West 31.5 feet North of the Corner.

We searched at least 50 feet in each direction for other stakes and found none that

might represent the Corner.

The measured dimensions to the Southwest and the Southeast Corners of Section 24 agree with the dimensions taken from recorded surveys, the most recent tax maps and/or other old surveys within one half of a foot.

This Corner was first recorded in 1972 by Oscar Boss in Liber 5935, Page 262, of the Oakland County Records.

SURVEYOR'S RECOMMENDATIONS:

Therefore, I recommend that the Peer Review Group accept this Corner as monumented, with the references as shown on the enclosed form prepared according to Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970.
