

DOSSIER FOR: THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13, MILFORD TOWNSHIP, T 2 N, R 7 E, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN. Prepared under contract with the County of Oakland Under Act 345 of the Public Acts of 1990.

HISTORY:

This Corner has been accepted and used since before 1961 as witnessed by the Road Commission for Oakland County at that time. It has not been recorded under Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970.1975.

COLLATERAL EVIDENCE:

We found a 1/2" iron pipe in an existing monument box in the Centerline of Wixom Road. We set a 5/8" iron rod and remonumentation cap in a new monument box. We found a 5/8" iron rod and remonumentation cap #25854 for the West 1/4 Corner of Section 18 of Commerce Township 97.56 feet South of the Corner. There is no evidence of occupation to the West of this Corner. We have no record distances North or South to the adjacent Government Corners. from this

We searched at least 50 feet in each direction for other stakes and found none that might represent the Corner.

SURVEYOR'S RECOMMENDATIONS:

This corner location is accepted by the Contractor and is generally accepted by Professional Surveyors as the best available evidence of the position of the original Corner. Therefore, I recommend that the Peer Review Group accept this Corner as monumented, with the references as shown on the enclosed form prepared according to Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970.
