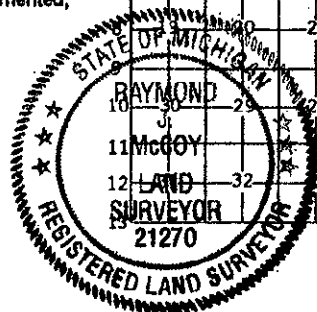

1817 Post GLO

2) 1987-Wilerson, L. 10244, Pg.7, Fd. 3/8" rod, 2 witnesses remain  
3) 1991-Kohn, L. 11170, Pg. 897, 2 witnesses recovered.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found capped iron(#26459), 500'+/-SSE from the EDS Building and North of the Clinton River and 35.66 feet North of a 1/2" rod(A-9, Avon Twp.). Recovered corner from the remaining witnesses in the above LCRC's and from various Surveys. Validated corner by measuring closely with the 1965 MSHD Survey South & West.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:  
Set a concrete monument consisting of a 1/2" iron rod encased in a 4" diameter concrete cylinder 36" long with a 2" diameter brass disk stamped Oakland County Remonumentation P.S. #21270.
