

DOSSIER FOR: THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7, SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP, T 4 N, R 8 E, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN. Prepared under contract with the County of Oakland Under Act 345 of the Public Acts of 1990.

#### **HISTORY:**

The boundary of this Township was surveyed by Alex Holmes, D.S. in 1815 and Joseph Wampler, D.S. set the Corners for the subdivision of it in 1823.

#### **SPECIAL NOTES:**

We set this Corner by single proportion measurement and on line with A-5 and C-5. This Corner has not been previously recorded.

### **COLLATERAL EVIDENCE:**

This Corner lies in a lake. We set a Reference Monument 520.18 feet Easterly of the Corner and on the Section Line. There is no evidence of occupation near this Corner. The measured dimensions agree with the GLO distances within about 15 feet.

#### SURVEYOR'S RECOMMENDATIONS:

The selected location is accepted by the Contractor and is generally accepted by Professional Surveyors as the best available evidence of the position of the original Corner. Therefore, I recommend that the Peer Review Group accept this Corner as monumented, with the references as shown on the enclosed form prepared according to Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970.
