DOSSIER FOR: THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6, SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP, T 4 N, R 8 E, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN. Prepared under contract with the County of Oakland Under Act 345 of the Public Acts of 1990.

HISTORY:

The boundary of this Township was surveyed by Alex Holmes, D.S. in 1815 and Joseph Wampler, D.S. set the Corners for the subdivision of it in 1823.

SPECIAL NOTES:

This Corner has been accepted and used since before 1962 as witnessed by the Road Commission for Oakland County at that time. It was recorded under Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970 in Liber 6373, Page 858, by John D. Albright, Surveyor in 1972. I used and recorded the wrong Corner in Liber 15671, Page 113.

COLLATERAL EVIDENCE:

This Corner lies 1' West and 5' South of a fence corner with fence lines running North, East and West. There are two more fences running North and South, along with two rock rows, 27' East and 20' West of the Corner.

We searched at least 50 feet in each direction for other stakes and found none that

We searched at least 50 feet in each direction for other stakes and found none that might represent the Corner. However, there is an iron rod that I erroneously called the Corner in 1995, which is East 27.08 from the true Corner.

The measured distances to the Southwest Corner and the Northwest Corner of Section 5 agrees with the record within 2.5 feet and 0.5 feet respectively.

SURVEYOR'S RECOMMENDATIONS:

The selected location is accepted by the Contractor and is generally accepted by Professional Surveyors as the best available evidence of the position of the original Corner. Therefore, I recommend that the Peer Review Group accept this Corner as monumented, with the references as shown on the enclosed form prepared according to Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970.
