

DOSSIER FOR: THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8, SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP, T 4 N, R 8 E, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN. Prepared under contract with the County of Oakland Under Act 345 of the Public Acts of 1990.

HISTORY:

The boundary of this Township was surveyed by Alex Holmes, D.S. in 1815 and Joseph Wampler, D.S. set the Corners for the subdivision of it in 1823.

SPECIAL NOTES:

This Corner has been accepted and used since before 1937 as evidenced by the recorded Supervisor's Plat No. 3, as recorded in Liber 28, Page 32. This Corner was first recorded under Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970 by James J. Scharl, Surveyor in Liber 10380, Page 673.

COLLATERAL EVIDENCE:

This Corner lies in a wooded area. There is no evidence of occupation in the vicinity of the Corner. We replaced the existing concrete monument with a new one with a Remonumentation Cap at the Northwest corner of Supervisor's Plat No. 3.

Remonumentation Cap at the Northwest corner of Supervisor's Plat No. 3. The measured dimensions to the Northwest Corner and the Northeast Corner of Section 17 agree with the recorded distances within 0.1 feet and 0.5 feet respectively.

We searched at least 50 feet in each direction for other stakes and found none that might represent the Corner.

SURVEYOR'S RECOMMENDATIONS:

The selected location is accepted by the Contractor and is generally accepted by Professional Surveyors as the best available evidence of the position of the original Corner. Therefore, I recommend that the Peer Review Group accept this Corner as monumented, with the references as shown on the enclosed form prepared according to Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970.
