

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.





DOSSIER FOR: THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 9, SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP, T 4 N, R 8 E, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN, Prepared under contract with the County of Oakland Under Act 345 of the Public Acts of 1990.

HISTORY:

The boundary of this Township was surveyed by Alex Holmes, D.S. in 1815 and Joseph Wampler, D.S. set the Corners for the subdivision of it in 1823.

SPECIAL NOTES:

This Corner has been accepted and used since before 1974 as witnessed by the Road Commission for Oakland County at that time. It was recorded under Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970 in Liber 6347, Page 183, by N. C. Jones, Surveyor in 1974.

COLLATERAL EVIDENCE:

This Corner lies 10 feet North of the Centerline of Davisburg Road and 182 feet West of the West edge of the concrete bridge deck for I-75. There is no evidence of occupation near this Corner.

We searched at least 50 feet in each direction for other stakes and found none that

might represent the Corner.

The measured dimensions to the South 1/4 Corner and the East 1/4 Corner of Section 9 and the North 1/4 Corner and the West 1/4 Corner of Section 15 agree with the recorded distances within 0.3 feet, 0.04 feet, 0.3 feet and 0.3 feet respectively.

SURVEYOR'S RECOMMENDATIONS:

The selected location is accepted by the Contractor and is generally accepted by Professional Surveyors as the best available evidence of the position of the original Corner. Therefore, I recommend that the Peer Review Group accept this Corner as monumented (while considering the iron rod found 5.32 feet Easterly), with the references as shown on the enclosed form prepared according to Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970.
