DOSSIER FOR: THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22, OAKLAND TOWNSHIP, T 4 N, R 11 E, OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN. Prepared under contract with the County of Oakland Under Act 345 of the Public Acts of 1990.

HISTORY:

This Township was originally surveyed by Joseph Wampler, Deputy Surveyor, in 1817.

SPECIAL NOTES:

After reviewing the Original GLO Notes and the transcripts, I do not believe that the original survey lines were run as documented, at least in order. Inconsistencies are evidenced by the sequence of page numbers, missing pages and inserted pages from other books in the original notebook. I expect that some lines were not measured or measured in the opposite directions indicated and that a tally (330 feet) was dropped in the fourth mile from the South line of the Township. This helps to explain large discrepancies between the GLO dimensions and what we are measuring today between Corners and noted features.

This Corner has been accepted and used since before 1977, as evidenced by a recording

under Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970.

Based on the 40 chains recorded in the original GLO Notes, this Corner is approximately 270 feet North of its original position. However, I have been unable to prove any other location employing dimensions to features originally cited in the Notes. This Corner is within 3 feet of a split between the Northwest Corner and the Southwest Corner of Section 23.

The County Surveyor's records of January 24, 1862 confirm the general dimensions that we find today around Section 23 within 2 to 112 feet.

COLLATERAL EVIDENCE:

This Corner lies 1.7 feet West of the Centerline of Rochester Road. There is a tree row that runs to the West of this Corner and a tree row and fence line running East. There is also a tree row running South 31 feet West of the Corner.

We searched at least 50 feet in each direction for other stakes and found none that

might represent the Corner.

The measured dimension to the Northwest Corner of Section 23 agrees with dimensions taken from recorded surveys, the most recent tax maps and/or other old surveys within 1 foot.

This Corner was recorded initially in 1973 by James H. Buckerfield, Surveyor, in Liber 7618, Page 840, of the Oakland County Records.

SURVEYOR'S RECOMMENDATIONS:

Therefore, I recommend that the Peer Review Group accept this Corner as monumented, with the references as shown on the enclosed form prepared according to Act 74 of the Public Acts of 1970.
