B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

I found a 3/8" Pipe in the centerline of road to the east along the south edge of a 5"x5" granite stone. Corner is on the west side of a pine plantation to the northeast of the corner. Corner is 15' west of trail to the south and is 33' east of driveway to the north. Both Griffin, 1974 witnesses are standing and measure OK, except the 9" Oak is now a recent 16" stump. Upon excavation, I found the stone to be 5"x5"x8" roughly rectangular.

I accept the Pipe as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. No evidence is known to me that would lead me to believe the corner should be at another location.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 4"x20" Harrison Cast Iron Monument, stamped "County Surveyor" and "26457" above the Pipe which was driven down. The stone was placed in the hole this ide the monument.
