Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner I found an old well-rotted 1/2"x18" Pipe 4" below the surface and in the centerline intersection of an east-west asphalt road and north-south gravel road. The early OCRC witness describes the same stone as Edson, 1881. Later OCRC added a 1/2" Pipe. The OCRC witness to the Tel. Pole at N30°E is probably N30°W to an existing pole. All other OCRC witnesses are standing and measure consistent to the pipe. Further search of the area failed to yield any other evidence for a conflicting position for the corner.
