B. Description of corn	er evidence found and/or meti	hod applied in restoring or rec	establishing co	orner,					

I found a PK Nail in the surface and centerline of an east-west asphalt road and on an old fence to the south and tree line and occupation line to the north. This PK also would fit the face of a former 12" Maple OCRC witness tree. Upon removal and excavation to 24" below the surface, I found a 1-1/4" wide cast iron which appears to be a wheel- broken and about 12" in diameter standing vertically. The Pk was an acceptable riser for this Iron wheel. The fron is not easily described which explains why OCRC would just call it an "fron".

This Iron was accepted as the best evidence of the corner and was accepted as being a careful and faithful perpetuation of the original corner. No evidence is known to me that would lead me to believe that the corner should be in another location.

I set a 5/8"x36" Iron with a 2" aluminum cap stamped "Oceana County Remonumentation" and "26457" at the position of the PK Nail which is directly above the cast iron "wheel".
