B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

I found a 5/8" Iron in the centerline intersection of roads E-W and N-S. This corner was established by GLO as a common corner with T13N & T14N. Both OCRC witnesses are gone. At 12" deep, I found it to be a riser for a solid 1-1/2" Iron. This corner is substantially as described by OCRC. I did not continue digging to attempt to find the Cedar Post by Grant, 1891.

I accept the Iron as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. No evidence is known to me that would lead me to believe the corner
