

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

I found an old car axle shaft in the centerline intersection of road N-S and E-W. The Iron Pipe referred to by Clapp was pulled by me in 1998 and discarded. All of OCRC witnesses are gone. Witness No. 3 is same for OCRC & Clapp, but is now gone. Only Witness No. 7 is still standing and
