B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner

I found a 3/4" dia Iron inside a monument box in the center of an east-west asphalt road and on a tree line to the south. The 1949 OCRC witness to the 20" Maple N65°E 71.5' is the same tree as MDSH. Also OCRC witness to a 20" Walnut is still standing although the size recited is questionable for 1949 as it is an 18" Walnut today. Early OCRC witnesses are usually to the face of the object. The only MDSH witness standing is the 12" Apple.

The Found 3/4" Iron inside a monment box is ACCEPTED AS A This represents the best available evidence for the position of the corner. CAREFUL AND FAITHFUL PERPETUATION OF THE POSITION OF THE ORGINAL CORNER.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner. i set a brass-cap 2 3/4"x20" cast iron Harrison monument on top of 3/4" from inside a Monument Box
