

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

C-6 1/4 CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 17 AND 18 T14N, R17W SHELBY TOWNSHIP

GLO SET POST 16"Beech N69°E 13.9' 18" Beech S08°W 29.0'

OCRC WITNESS: Undated 3/4

OCRC, Hepworth, PS26457, July, 1989; Found 1/2" pipe inside a Monument Box; No witnesses taken. Monument Box was reset during 1991 Road reconstruction.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner

I found a 1/2" Pipe inside a Monument Box at the surface of an east-west asphalt Road. Center of the asphalt road is 4.5' south. Center of a sand trail to south and on projection of old-abandoned road to north. The MDSH witness to the 13" Ash is still standing and measures good. MDSH measured distance to A-6 from this corner is 5306.52', JRH measured distance is 5306.12'; MDSH measured distance to MDSH C-6 monument is 2645.07', JRH measured distance is 2644.04'. These distance relationships are consistent with other comparisons to MDSH measurements elsewhere. Upon excavation to set the monument, I found a 3/4" square Iron 20" below surface of asphalt.

Further search of the area failed to yield any other evidence for a conflicting position for the corner. This represents the best available evidence for the position of the corner. The Found 1/2" pipe IS ACCEPTED AS A CAREFUL AND FAITHFUL PERPETUATION OF THE POSITION OF THE ORGINAL CORNER.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner. I set a brass-cap 2 3/4" cast iron Harrison monument on top of the 1/2" Pipe inside Monument Box flush in asphalt road
