

Randolph Hepworth in a field survey on do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

I-8 1/4 CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 22 & 23 T14N, R17W SHELBY TOWNSHIP

Set post 8"Lynn S76°F 13.2' 15"Beech S74°W 15.2 No other historical documentation is known to me.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

I found at the intersection of old woven-wire fence lines N-S and E-W (lying down) a red granite stone. This Stone is nicely dressed with flat sides standing vertical - 4"x5" at the top, pyramidical shaped to 7"x10" at the base and 20" long. Stone was found to be braced with small stones at the base.

This represents the best available evidence for the position of the corner. The found stone is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. No evidence is known to me that would lead me to believe that the corner should be at another location. It placed a 4"x20" Harrison Cast Iron Monument stamped "County Surveyor" and "26457" at the position found and laid the stone back in the excavated hole on the north side of the monument.
