

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner

I found an Engine Valve in the surface of the center of an east-west asphalt road. A tree line is to the south and the center of a gravel drive to the Ross Witness trees measure consistent. north is 10' west. The OCRC Elm witnesses found by Ross are no longer visible.

Upon removal of the Engine Valve, I excavated to 36" below surface and found a plow point beside a 8" granite stone.

This represents the best available evidence for Further search of the area failed to yield any other evidence for a conflicting position for the corner. The Found Engine Valve riser IS ACCEPTED AS A CAREFUL AND FAITHFUL PERPETUATION OF THE POSITION the position of the corner. OF THE ORGINAL CORNER.
