B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner

I found an engine valve in the surface and center of an east-west asphalt road. No occupation lines exist north or south. OCRC measurements to the Barn fit very close; Barn has a rough stone foundation with about 8' walls of stone. No other OCRC witnesses are standing.

Upon removal of the engine valve, I excavated to 16" and found a 2.5" very brittle pipe which could be a Boiler Flue. Found large blue granite stones on the south and east sides. After the granite stone was removed, I found on the north side of the Boiler flue pipe a yellow-red Pointed granite stone approximately 6"x6"x18" which I left in place.

This represents the best available evidence for Further search of the area failed to yield any other evidence for a conflicting position for the corner. The Found engine valve riser above the described materials IS ACCEPTED AS A CAREFUL AND FAITHFUL PERPETUATION OF THE POSITION OF THE ORGINAL CORNER.
