B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

I found a JRH 1/2" Iron in the centerline of N-S Road under construction. An old fence lying down runs to the east and I detected intermittent fence wire at the edge of the field lane running to the west of this iron. Upon excavation and removal, I found it to be a riser for a 5/8" Iron at 24" deep. Upon further excavation, I found the 5/8" Iron to be directly beside on the south side of a gray, granite stone about 6"x8"x8"± at original soil grade at 30" deep. I believe the 5/8" Iron is the 1/2" Pipe called for by Ross and the 1/2" Iron pin by OCRC. All 3 OCRC witnesses are standing and measure OK to the face. I did not find the Hyde, 1888, pipe.

I accept the 5/8" Iron, 1/2" Iron and stone as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. No evidence is known to me that would lead me to believe the corner should be at another location.
