I found a 1 1/4" Well Point pipe in the center of a T-Road Intersection. This witness is still standing and is now a 48" Maple. The Blass Witness to a 8" Ash is still standing and is now a 12" Ash. The OCRC Witness to a 24" Maple is probably the same as Blass, 1968. section of road approximately 3 feet deep. No excavation was made to discover if the Well Point is above the corner described by Hyde, 1889. This corner falls in a fill
